


Android notifications are great, but they're not perfect. The way that some notifications pop up on the screen can be annoying, especially if they're not important. Thankfully, you can stop this from happening. The bad news is that there's no way to turn off pop-up notifications all at once. You'll have to do it individually by app. The process is easy, though, so if you do it every time an annoying notification comes in, you'll have things cleaned up in no time. First, swipe down from the top of your device's screen (once or twice, depending on your phone or tablet's manufacturer) and tap the gear icon to open the Settings menu. Next, select "Apps & Notifications." Tap "See All [Number] Apps" for the full list of installed apps. Find the app that's giving you annoying pop-up notifications. Now, select "Notifications." Here, you'll see all of the different Notification Channels for the app. Unfortunately, you'll have to go into each channel separately to turn off pop-up notifications. Select one to get started. Next, look for "Pop On Screen" and toggle it off. Repeat this process for any app as well as the Notification Channels you'd like to stop popping up. Primakov/Shutterstock.com Since its birth, Android has had to deal with one big misconception. Some phone makers have even helped perpetuate this myth. The truth is you do not need to kill Android apps. In fact, closing apps can make things worse. It's unclear where this idea came from, but it's been present on Android since the very beginning. "Task Killer" apps were very popular in the early days. Even as a techy person, I was guilty of using them at one time. It's understandable to think closing background apps would be a good thing, but we'll explain why it's not. The Temptation Where does this compulsory need to close background apps come from? I think there are a few things at play. First of all, it seems to be common sense. An app is running in the background, I am not using it, therefore the app does not need to be open. Pretty straightforward logic. We can also look at the way we use computers, which predates smartphones. Generally, people keep apps open while they're using them, opening and minimizing as needed. But when you're done with an app, you click the "X" button to close it. That action has a very clear intent and result. Conversely, when you're done with an Android app, you typically go back to the home screen or lock the device. Are you actually closing it? People have looked for ways to close apps, and app developers and phone makers have been more than happy to provide methods to do it. How to Close Android Apps It's probably a good time to talk about what we actually mean when we say "kill" or "close" an Android app. It's the action of manually dismissing an app from the Recent Apps screen. On most Android devices, you can open the Recent Apps by swiping up from the bottom of the screen and holding it for a second halfway up. The other method is to simply tap the square icon on the navigation bar. You'll now see the apps that have been recently opened. Swipe up on any of the apps to close or kill them. Sometimes there's a trash icon underneath that you can also use. There's usually an option to "Close All" too, but that is never necessary. Android Has It Covered The common thought is closing background apps will improve battery life, speed up your phone, and reduce data usage. However, you can actually do more harm than good. It all comes down to how Android was designed to run apps. Android was specifically made to have a bunch of apps in the background. When the system requires more resources, it will automatically close apps for you. It's simply not something you need to do yourself. Plus, it's a good thing to have apps running in the background. They will launch very quickly when you open them, making your phone feel faster. That doesn't mean every app you've ever opened is sitting there eating up resources. Android will close unused apps as needed. Again, it's not something you have to manage yourself. In fact, all of that closing and opening can have a negative effect on performance. It takes more power to open an app from a cold state compared to one that is already sitting in the memory. You're taxing the CPU and the battery, which will have the exact opposite effect that you were intending. If you're worried about background data usage, that's something you can disable on an app-by-app basis. It's rare for a background app to use a lot of data, but if there's a culprit on your phone, you can fix that without constantly closing it. RELATED: How to Stop Android Apps from Using Background Mobile Data When Is It Necessary? We've outlined why you shouldn't kill Android apps, but the functionality is there for a reason. There are situations in which it's necessary to take control and manually close an app. If you ever notice an app misbehaving, a simple restart will usually solve the problem. The app may be displaying things incorrectly, having trouble loading something, or just plain frozen. Closing the app—or restarting your phone, in extreme cases—is a good place to start the troubleshooting. In addition to the Recent Apps method explained above, you can also close apps from the Android Settings menu. Open the Settings and find the "Apps" section. From the app's information page, select "Force Stop" or "Force Close." The moral of the story here is these things are already being handled. You don't have to worry about managing background apps. A capable operating system is on the job. You can rest easy knowing Android has it under control. There certainly are occasions where Android doesn't handle it well, but that's not often the case. Usually, it's apps that misbehave more than Android itself. In those situations, you know what to do, but in general, just let Android be Android. RELATED: How to Stop Android From Killing Background Apps Much to the chagrin of big tech companies, nobody wants their smartphones to spy on them. By default, however, our mobile devices track our every move—and share that data with other apps and services. Luckily, as with most things on Android, you don't need to live with the default setup presented to you. Instead, you can manage your location services to fit your privacy values. How to disable Location entirely on Android You can disable Location on Android so no location data is shared to Google or any of your other apps. To do so, swipe down from the top of the screen, then long-press Location (the icon appears as a "location arrow"). If you don't see Location here, tap "Edit" or "Settings," then drag Location into your Quick Settings. While this might be the best way to secure your location privacy on Android, it isn't particularly convenient. Any apps that need location data to function, such as Google Maps, simply won't work with this setting turned off. If you can live with that, you can have a location-free Android experience. But for most of us, we're better off tinkering with other location settings. How to disable location permissions for apps Instead of turning off Location entirely on Android, you'll likely find it more useful to manage permissions for each of your apps. Not all apps are equal, of course, so you'll likely want to give some apps more access to location, and hold back for others. Head to Settings > Location > App permission. You'll see three categories: Allowed all the time, which contains apps that have access to your location whenever they want; Allowed only while in use, which contains apps that can only use your location when those apps are active; and Ask every time, which contains apps that must ask permission to use your location every time. Tap any of these categories to view the apps with those permissions. To change the permission for a particular app, tap the app, and choose a new option. Alternatively, you can change location permissions for apps one-by-one. Long-press the app in question on your phone's home screen, then tap the (i). Choose Permissions > Location, then choose one of the three above categories, or Deny, which will block that app from your location information. How to disable Location Accuracy on Android Android uses Location Accuracy to determine your precise location; it takes your GPS, wifi, mobile network, and phone sensor information to give you location-based suggestions, as well as show your exact location on-screen. This can be useful for certain apps, but you might be uncomfortable with both Google and its connected apps and services having access to that data. To disable Location Accuracy, head to Settings > Location > Advanced > Google Location Accuracy, then disable Improve Location Accuracy. When you disable this feature, Google will only be able to use GPS to determine your location. Not totally private, but also much less accurate than the default. How to delete & disable Location History on Android Location history is exactly what it sounds like; Google saves a record of the places you go with your smartphone to power things like recommendations, helping you find your phone, and real-time traffic updates. To many of us, however, it's a bit creepy. To disable Location History, head to your Google Account's Activity controls. Sign in if you aren't already. View Location History, and choose "Turn off." On the pop-up, choose "Pause," and a new pop-up will appear. Choose "Delete old activity," and Google will launch a Location History map; here, you can see pinpoints for all locations you've been with Google. To delete this info, just click the trash can in the bottom right, click the checkbox on the pop-up, then click "DELETE LOCATION HISTORY." You can also choose for Google to automatically delete your Location History after a set period of time. From your Activity controls page, select the option under Auto-delete, choose the option under Auto-delete activity older than, then choose either 3 months, 18 months, or 36 months. Choose Next to save your choice. How to disable Location sharing If you have Location sharing enabled, but regret sharing your whereabouts with your contacts list, you can easily turn this feature off. Open Google Maps, tap your profile icon, then choose Location sharing. Tap the profile of the contact you don't want to share your location with any longer, then tap Stop to confirm. How to disable location permissions for web browsing Google gives you controls over which websites have your location information. To disable location permission for a website, go to that website in your browser. Tap the Lock to the left of the address bar, tap Permissions, then turn Location off for that website. Of course, you can disable location permissions for your entire browser; just follow the instructions above for disabling location permissions for specific apps (in this case, a browser like Chrome or Firefox).
